

Which of the following Fun Facts make you say...

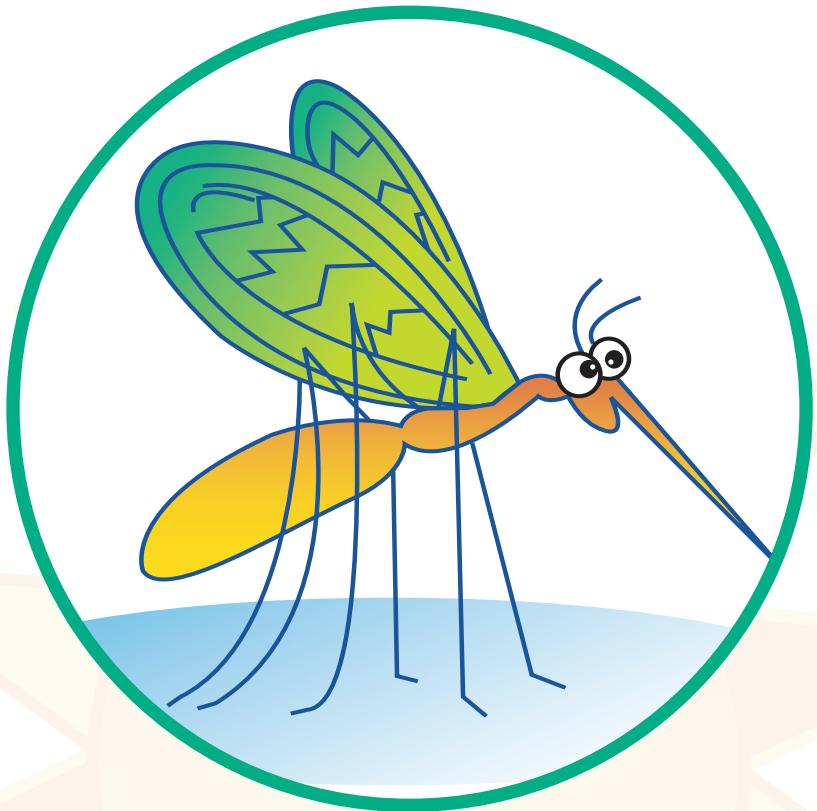


DIDN'T KNOW THAT!
